

CALL FOR SUMMER SCHOOL GRANTS

The Institute of Nanoscience of Aragón (INA), in the framework of the TRAIN2 European Project led by this Institution, offers thirty three grants for the attendance at the [Transpyrenees Summer School on Nanosciences and Nanotechnologies](#) that will take place in Jaca (Spain) from the 16th to the 20th July 2012.

Applicants should send an e-mail before the 18th May at 14:00 h to the course directors, Dr. Pilar Cea (pilarcea@unizar.es) and Dr. Jose María de Teresa (deteresa@unizar.es), with the following information:

- A single PDF file (written in English) containing:
 1. Your full name.

 4. Recommendation letter from a tutor or supervisor at your home institution.
 5. Motivation letter.
 6. Your CV (including your average mark in your degree and master, level of English, publications, and conferences).

The grants outcome is expected for the 28th May 2012.

DETAILS OF THE CALL

Eligibility criteria

Degree

Applicants should have graduated or at least be in the 4th or 5th year of a Science degree related to the nanoscience field (e.g. Physics, Chemistry, Pharmacy, Biology, Biomedicine, Engineering, etc.).

Language and proficiency

The application is to be made in English. The applicant should have a very good command of the English language since the summer school will be in English.

Nationality

30 grants are for students belonging to the SUDOE region (France, Portugal and Spain) and 3 grants are for students belonging to a European region outside the SUDOE area.

Selection procedure

Eligibility check

Application files that do not comply with all eligibility criteria or submission requirements, will not be considered for selection.

Selection criteria

The recommendations are based on:

- The qualifications of the applicant.
- The motivation of the applicant.

Funding

Each grant covers the matriculation fees, accommodation and breakfast at Residencia Universitaria de Jaca (double room), as well as travel expenses (original tickets for public transport will be required, with the grant covering a maximum of 250 € for international students).
